SUBJECT: Notice of Scheduled Construction Works and Temporary Operational Measures at the Cargo Terminal – Import Dock

Dear Users,

Greetings from ADIMEX El Salvador SPE, S.A. de C.V., concessionaire of the Cargo Terminal at El Salvador International Airport Saint Óscar Arnulfo Romero y Galdámez (AIESSOARG).

As part of the “Expansion and Modernization of the Cargo Terminal at El Salvador International Airport” project, we hereby inform you that construction activities in the Import Cargo Dock area will commence on June 19, 2026.

We kindly request your cooperation in keeping the affected areas clear and making the necessary operational arrangements to minimize disruptions during the execution of these works, particularly at dock positions 5 through 8.

Temporary Operational Measures (Effective June 20, 2026)

To ensure operational continuity and minimize impacts during the construction period, the following temporary measures will be implemented:

- Dispatch area operating hours will be extended from Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., and Saturdays from 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
- Exit Pass submissions will be accepted until 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Requests submitted after this time will be subject to ADIMEX operational review and availability.
- To optimize the use of the maneuvering yard and improve service times, once the first cargo pickup notification has been issued, users will have a maximum of thirty (30) minutes to complete the operation. After this period, cargo will be transferred to temporary storage, and applicable charges will be applied according to the current tariff schedule.
- An appointment scheduling system will be implemented for customers with recurring or high-volume operations to improve operational planning and service efficiency.

- As part of the temporary measures resulting from the construction activities, access for articulated trucks will only be permitted between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Vehicles arriving outside this timeframe will be attended during extended operating hours after 5:30 p.m., subject to operational availability and applicable tariff charges.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation during this modernization phase, which will contribute to strengthening the operational capacity, security, and quality of services provided by the Cargo Terminal.
